



## **JOB POSTING: DATA ANALYST**

### **Tanzania MNCH Initiatives – Mama na Mtoto Strategic Partnerships & Community Engagement Cumming School of Medicine University of Calgary**

The Mama na Mtoto partnership aims to enhance maternal, newborn, and child health (MNCH) in two districts of Mwanza Region, Tanzania through implementation of a model to strengthen health districts, health facilities, and community capacity.

Our team is seeking a Data Analyst to assist with analysis of midline quantitative Health Facility Survey data conducted in Tanzania. Note that coding is already available from prior baseline analyses using R statistical software; therefore, the ideal candidate will have knowledge of R. Duties may be completed remotely, with in-person progress meetings at the University of Calgary. This position is supervised by Hannah Mercader, Project Coordinator, working closely with Dr. Jenn Brenner, Global MNCH Director.

This is a short-term casual position with up to a maximum of 30 x 7-hour shifts in a calendar year. We expect the actual time required to complete duties to be fewer than 10-15 shifts, depending on the level of experience. Rate of pay will be determined based on qualifications as per the University of Calgary AUPE Salary Schedule.

#### **Duties:**

- Data cleaning as required, including creating combined variables
- Analysis of non-composite and composite indicators by September 30, 2018
- Prepare tables, graphs, comparative data displays, and/or reports for key findings
- Provide documentation of data analysis processes/coding
- Participate in meetings with the Project Coordinator to review workload and progress

#### **Qualifications:**

- At least a Master's degree in biostatistics or equivalent (graduate students are eligible to apply)
- Experience with analyzing large sets of data
- Knowledge of R statistical software is preferred
- Availability and ability to complete analysis during September is preferred
- Understanding of maternal, newborn, and child health metrics is an asset
- Experience with global/international health research is an asset
- In addition to the above data analysis skills, the following qualities are essential:
  - Organized and detail-oriented
  - Effective oral and written communication skills
  - Able to work independently within time constraints
  - Proactive and willing to take initiative
